

Teach for Texas Loan Repayment Assistance Program Application Information and Instructions

Please carefully read the following information before completing your application.

The purpose of the Teach for Texas Loan Repayment Assistance Program is to recruit and retain classroom teachers in communities and subjects for which there is an acute shortage of teachers in Texas.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Be currently teaching full-time at the preschool, primary, or secondary level in a Texas public school
- 2. Be certified in a field identified by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) as experiencing a shortage of teachers during the academic year for which the application is submitted and teach full-time in that field

or

Be certified and teach full-time at a campus identified by TEA as having a shortage of teachers during the academic year for which the application is submitted

3. Submit a completed application to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) during the annual application period between April 1st and June 15th for teaching service being completed during the current academic year. Faxed applications are *not* accepted.*

Loan Repayment Assistance

- Loan repayment assistance received through this program is considered taxable income by the Internal Revenue Service and will be reported as such by THECB.
- The maximum repayment amount for one academic year of teaching service is \$5,000, and the aggregate maximum per applicant is \$20,000.
- A teacher may not receive loan repayment assistance from this program for more than five years.
- Annual loan repayment assistance funds are disbursed after verification of eligible teaching for a complete academic year and made co-payable to the participant and the holder of the loan.
- Due to limited funding, not all eligible applicants receive loan repayment assistance. The following criteria are used to rank eligible applicants: (a) Renewal applicants shall be given priority over first-time applicants unless a break in service periods has occurred, (b) Financial need as evidenced by the total amount of student loan indebtedness, and (c) Severity of shortage of teachers in the community or teaching field.

Eligible Loans

- Must be evidenced by a promissory note which explicitly required the loan proceeds to be used to pay the costs incurred by attending a public or private institution of higher education
- Must have an outstanding balance that is not currently being repaid through another loan repayment program
- Must not be in default status

Shortage Areas

Designated Shortage Campuses:

The federal Title I designation is not used to determine campus eligibility for the Teach for Texas Loan Repayment Assistance Program. Shortage campus designation for this program is based on information provided annually by Texas Education Agency.

Designated Shortage Fields:

Mathematics, Science, Special Education, Languages other than English, Bilingual/English as a Second Language, and Technology Applications (Technology {Computer} Applications, Computer Science I, Computer Science II, Desktop Publishing, Digital Graphics, Multimedia, Video Technology, Web Mastering and Independent Study in Technology Applications).

Privacy Act Notice

Certain information required on the application is made confidential by the Privacy Act of 1974 (5 USC 552a). The requested information is necessary for participation in the Teach for Texas Loan Repayment Assistance Program, to verify your identity and to determine your eligibility for the program and for any benefits from it. As an identifier, the SSN will be used to determine program eligibility.
